The payment for care shall be \$15 per **half** day per child (less than 5.5 hours)

The payment for care shall be \$26 per **full** day per child (more than 5.5 hours)

Late Pick-Up/late payment fees:

If parent is going to be late picking up the child, every effort must be made to contact the provider. A late pick up fee of \$ 25 per 10 minutes (past 6:00 pm) will be charged. Payment is due to the provider upon receipt of billing (via e-mail, bi weekly). Accepted methods of payment include cash, personal check, credit card, or money order. If a personal check is returned due to a lack of funds, the parent/guardian must pay a \$ 20 returned check fee. If a check is returned more than one time, only cash, money orders, or credit card will be accepted as payment.

If a payment is not made at least once per month, and all reasonable efforts have been made to collect payment, child will not be able to attend the Summer Program until balance is paid in full.

Payments during Holidays, Vacations, and Other absences:

The provider will not be open for business on the following Holiday: July 4th, 2018

If a parent plans on taking a vacation and the child will not be in care, the provider must be given 2 weeks' notice. Parents are not expected to pay during their scheduled vacations. If a child does not arrive for the day and no notice has been given to the provider, parents will not be charged that day.

Additional charges:

The provider will charge additional fees as follows: (i.e. for supplies, special trips, damaged property, etc).

Termination Procedures:

This contract may be terminated by the parent(s) or the provider. A 2-week notice prior to the last date of care is required.

The provider may immediately terminate this contract without any notice if payment is not made on time.

Other:

- *The contract can be revised at any time by the provider if necessary.*
